4. Provide a letter of recommendation from his/her immediate advisor, supervisor, counselor, or department head.
5. Submit a personal letter explaining his./her need and general outline of past personal qualifications and future plans toward an agricultural vocation in 500 words or less.
6. Complete and submit an Oregon Feed and Grain Association scholarship application.
